Chapter Membership Composition

Chapters must meet the following requirements with regards to the individual members of their chapter:

1.) INDUSTRY

At least 75% of the individual members must be currently employed in a substantially full-time, professional position, the primary responsibilities of which are in one or more of the qualified fields of commercial real estate (QFCRE).



2.) EXPERIENCE

A majority (> 50%) of individual members must have at least five years of experience in a qualified field (QFCRE).



Recommended Membership Categories

CREW Network recommends that chapters pick from the following six categories of membership:

Full member: employed in a substantially full-time, professional position, the primary responsibilities of which are in one or more of the QFCREs

Affiliate member: employed in a field related to CRE which supplies a service or product to Full members

Graduate student member: full-time graduate student (pursing career in a QFCRE)

- *Undergraduate student member: full-time undergraduate student pursuing a career in a QFCRE
- *Civic member: employed by government or public agency, or a non-profit. Certain Civic members may actually qualify as Full members; chapters may choose to use this category if they would like to offer a discounted rate.
- *Retired member: existing member who has retired from employment in CRE. Chapters may choose to recategorize and offer a discounted rate to keep these individuals involved.
