Erin Schoop is a principal at Hartshorne Plunkard Architecture (HPA), a Chicago-based design studio that specializes in urban mixed-use developments that share a common sensibility toward placemaking. Since joining HPA in 2011, Erin has contributed her inquisitiveness, creativity, and meticulous eye for detail to the large-scale, mixed-use commercial, residential and hospitality projects she's managed. Her responsibilities include overseeing detailed drawing sets, consultant coordination, and providing on-site construction administration.

Erin's project portfolio includes **One Chicago**, a 2.2M SF, mixed-use, multi-tower development that is the city's 8th tallest skyscraper and its largest residential tower; **North Union**, a master planned residential community with 14 new construction and adaptive reuse buildings on an eight-acre site in Chicago; and the **WeWork Fulton Market Flagship** in Fulton Market, which was honored with a Chicago Landmarks Preservation Excellence Award.

Erin is a licensed Architect and a Certified Document Technologist. She received her Master of Architecture from the University of Utah and a Bachelor of Science in Architecture from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign.
