UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT MEMBER \$180

Full-time undergraduate student pursing career in a Qualified Field of Commercial Real Estate

RETIRED MEMBER \$210

Existing member who has retired from employment in commercial real estate

ASSOCIATE MEMBER \$395

Employed in a substantially full-time, professional position, the primary responsibilities of which are in one or more of the Qualified Fields of Commercial Real Estate (less than 5 years experience)

GRADUATE STUDENT MEMBER \$280
