Frequently Asked Questions

What is CREW?

[CREW](#) stands for Commercial Real Estate Women. It is a global organization with a mission to advance women in commercial real estate through networking, industry research, leadership training, and career outreach. There are over 80 chapters and global affiliates. We belong to the CREW Austin Chapter.

What is CRE?

CRE stands for Commercial Real Estate. It refers to any property used to produce income. Many professionals are involved in CRE, including developers, analysts, accountants, attorneys, brokers, surveyors, engineers, architects, builders, property managers, leasing agents, and more.

What is UCREW?

UCREW is a program by the Career Development Committee within CREW Austin that focuses on university outreach and exposing college students to the world of CRE. The local CREW Austin chapter has a scholarship competition program and offers student memberships.

What is the UCREW Real Estate Challenge?

The [UCREW Real Estate Challenge](#) connects students with professionals and culminates in scholarship awards for top winners. It consists of three parts:

Session I: Art of the Deal (Feb 3, 2026 | 5:30-7pm | Virtual via Zoom)

- Students learn about the “art of the deal,” network with professionals, and hear more specifics on the competition requirements.

Session II: Mentorship (Feb 8, 2026 - Mar 7, 2026 | Virtual or In Person)

- Students will be paired with a professional mentor who is a member of CREW Austin.
- Students will work with their assigned mentor on submission materials for the scholarship competition.
- You will have the opportunity to ask your mentor about their career development and work on the submission materials for the scholarship competition together.

- Deliverables include a one-page executive brief and a short slide presentation addressing the prompt:
Describe a commercial real estate project you would like to be involved in, and based on your future career in real estate, describe ways in which you might be involved in the project.
- Students meet with their mentor at least 2 hours (virtually or in person) and then submit their executive brief and presentation slides by **March 8, 2026**.

Session III: Student Presentations & Scholarship Awards

(Mar 31, 2026 | 5:30-7pm | Virtual via Zoom)

- Finalists will be invited to present their project during Session III.
- We strongly encourage everyone to join both virtual nights for additional networking with local professionals.
- CREW Austin will award \$5,500 in scholarships to the top three winners, along with student memberships to the top five winners.

Can I participate if my field of study is not real estate?

Yes! We encourage students from all majors to participate because the world of CRE is extremely multi-faceted. Some roles require specific training or licensure, but not all. Many licenses do not require a specific major. Most roles require strong communication, organization, and project management skills, which are found in various majors. While architecture, engineering, business, and real estate students may seem an immediate fit for the CRE industry, many successful CREW businesswomen have degrees in communications, English, political science, criminology, and other fields that may initially seem unrelated. What is the CREW National/Network Scholarship?

In addition to the mentoring and scholarship program with the CREW Austin chapter, the national CREW Network organization offers a separate scholarship. Students can apply for the CREW Network scholarship independently of their participation in the CREW Austin scholarship program.

Who can participate?

- Women who are current undergraduate or graduate students with a minimum of two (2) completed semesters in college as of the application date.
- All majors will be considered. This is a multi-disciplinary program.
- Students interested in learning more about careers in Commercial Real Estate.
